****IMPORTANT CHANGES****

The United States Postal Service increased their postal rates on May 14th. In order to keep our fees charged to clients low, we will begin mailing client statements only on a quarterly basis. The last regular monthly statement you will receive from our office will be a June statement.

We will then only mail quarterly client statements for the following months:

January—March will be mailed at the end of March

April—June will be mailed at the end of June

July—September will be mailed at the end of September

October—December will be mailed at the end of December

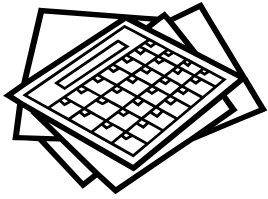
You will still be required to send your regular payments on a monthly basis.
