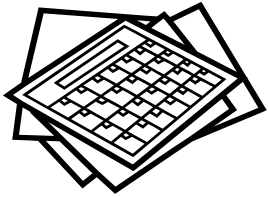
Reminders

We have many reminders for you. Please take note!

- ⇒ Please do not leave any payments at Center For Siouxland's front desk. All payments should either be mailed, placed in the drop box, or brought back to our office for a receipt. You may also utilize our automatic withdrawal system. We will not be responsible for lost or misplaced payments if they are left at our front desk.
- ⇒ We need to see client statements at least every three months. We do not get these directly from your creditors. We rely on you to provide us with updated information.
- ⇒ If you receive any notices from your creditors in the mail, you need to forward them on to your counselor. Credit card companies do not send a copy of these letters to us.
- ⇒ If you have been mailed an amendment or renewal agreement, please sign and return them as soon as possible.
- ⇒ We do not pay out partial payments. You must make a full payment for us to send it to your creditors.
- ⇒ You are able to check your accounts that are being paid through our office on the internet. If you have not yet utilized this function, please contact your counselor for more details.

Account Secure Plus Programs

If are currently being charged a fee each month for an Account Secure Plus Program, it is in your best interest to contact the creditor to get this feature canceled. This is an extra fee you are being charged each month, which in turn takes you longer to pay off your balance owed. Please check your statements.
