Each individual board member is expected to

- Know the organizations mission, policies, programs, and needs
- Faithfully read and understand the organization's financial statements
- Serves as active advocates and ambassadors for the organization and fully engage in identifying and securing the financial resources and partnerships necessary for Center For Siouxland to advance its mission
- Leverage connections, networks, and resources to develop collective action to fully achieve Center For Siouxland mission
- Give a meaningful personal financial donation
- Help identify personal connections that can benefit the organization's fundraising and reputational standing, and can influence public policy
- Prepare for, attend, and conscientiously participate in board meetings
- Participate fulling in one or more committees
- Follow the organization's by-laws, policies, and board resolutions
- Sign an annual conflict of interest disclosure and update it during the year if necessary, and disclose any potential conflicts before meetings and actual conflicts during meetings
- Maintain confidentiality about all internal matters of Center For Siouxland
